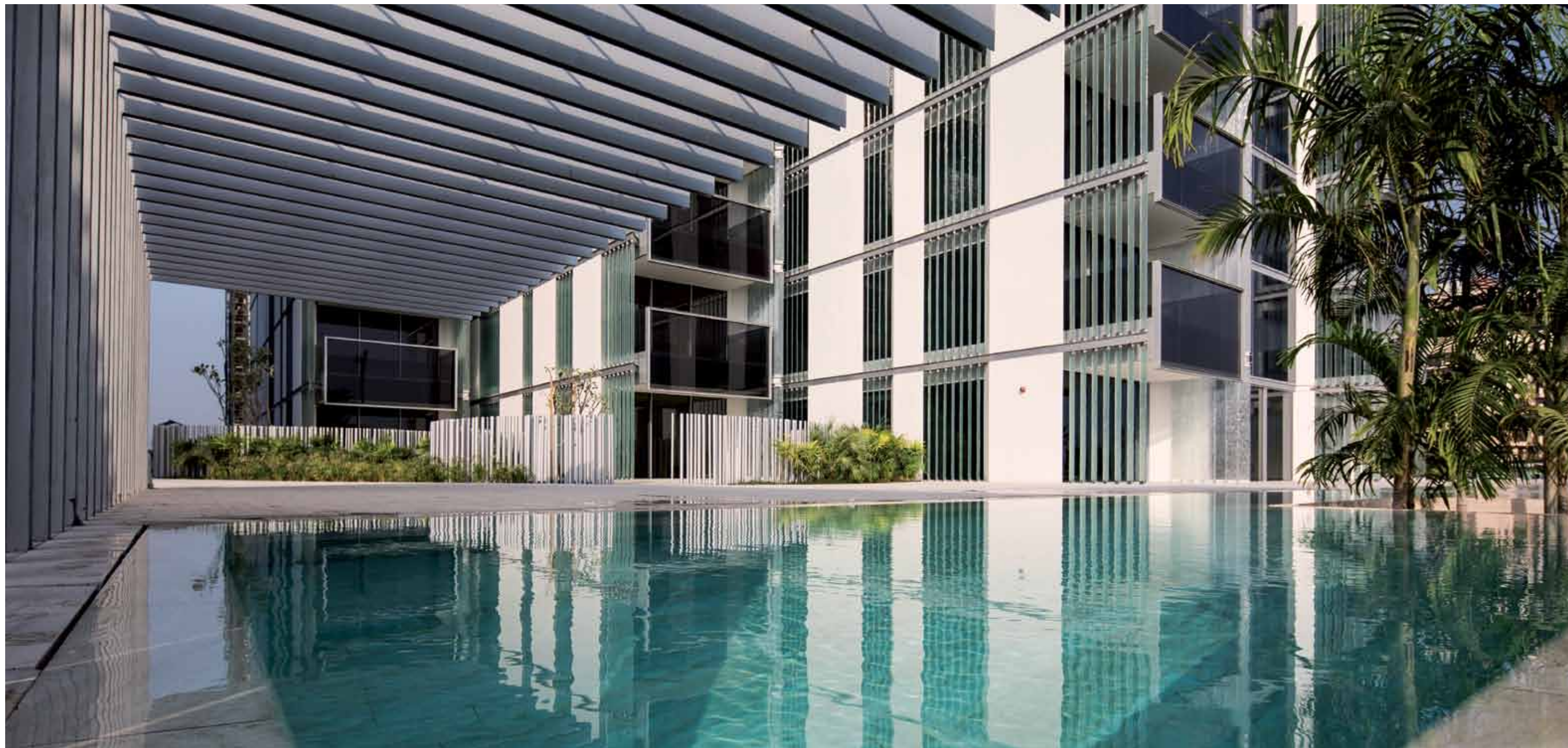
The architect's perspective
